Florence THIBAUT, M.D., Ph.D. in Neurosciences, Psychiatrist and Endocrinologist, is Professor of Psychiatry at the University Hospital Cochin and the Faculty of Medicine Paris Descartes, Paris, France.

Her main interests are schizophrenia, addictive disorders and treatment of paraphilias. She is also member of INSERM U 894 Centre of Psychiatry and Neurosciences, Paris V University.

She is Past President of the World Federation of Societies of Biological Psychiatry. She is Past President of the French Association for Biological Psychiatry.

Currently, she is Vice President of the French national society of professors involved in addictive behaviors and member of the Executive Committee of the French Society for Alcoholism (in charge of the Task Force alcohol and pregnancy).

She is author or coauthor of more than 190 papers (113 in PubMed), 5 books (genetics of schizophrenia, psychiatric aspects of deviant sexual disorders, neurosciences in psychiatry, sexual abuse, antipsychotics) and 60 books chapters.

She was an invited speaker in many national and international meetings (more than 400 communications including about 25 lectures).

She has coordinated several national and international congresses (current Chair of the next World Congress of Biological Psychiatry Athens June 2015). She was coordinator or co-author of several national and international guidelines (schizophrenia, sex offenders...).

She is WHO expert (addiction).

She is a Member of the editorial board of the World Journal of Biological Psychiatry and Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Emergency Mental Health.
