She is Member of the WHO expert panel (pharmacodependence). She is an EC Member of the International Neuropsychiatric Association (2013-) and of the French Society for Alcoholism (2013-). She is a member of the Advisory Board of the International Association for Women's Mental Health (2015-).

She is a Member of several national jury boards for grants allocations. She is a Member of the Editorial Board of the World Journal of Biological Psychiatry (2013-).

She is author or coauthor of more than 190 papers (119 in PubMed), 4 books (genetics of schizophrenia and psychiatric aspects of deviant sexual disorders, neurosciences in psychiatry, sexual abuse) and 60 books chapters. She was an invited speaker in many national and international meetings (more than 400 communications including about 20 lectures). She has coordinated several national and international congresses.
